Question 1: Where can I find information like the number of students enrolled or the number of degrees awarded?

- Institutional Research provides enrolment figures from two different sources.
- The first source, available in BI, is Mosaic. These are live enrolment figures that are refreshed nightly if changes are made in Mosaic. The BI reports have been vetted by a group of users and the Registrar's Office to confirm that they are an accurate reflection of what is in Mosaic.
- The second source, available on the IQAP Portal, is McMaster's government enrolment count (USER). USER is submitted to government six times a year. Often the November 1st submission is used when reporting enrolment figures. USER is a snapshot of what the university's enrolment looked like on that day. After the snapshot is taken, weeks of work is done to ensure the dataset is as clean and accurate as possible before submission. USER determines the university's enrolment-based funding.
- You may find small differences between the two enrolment reports. These differences are due to the timing of when the reports are generated.
- If you are looking for enrolment figures for anything budget or funding related, the government enrolment report on the IQAP portal is the most appropriate source until it migrates to Oracle BI.
- For all other purposes, use Oracle BI. The BI reports come from Mosaic and are updated nightly, so what you see in BI will match what you see in Mosaic.

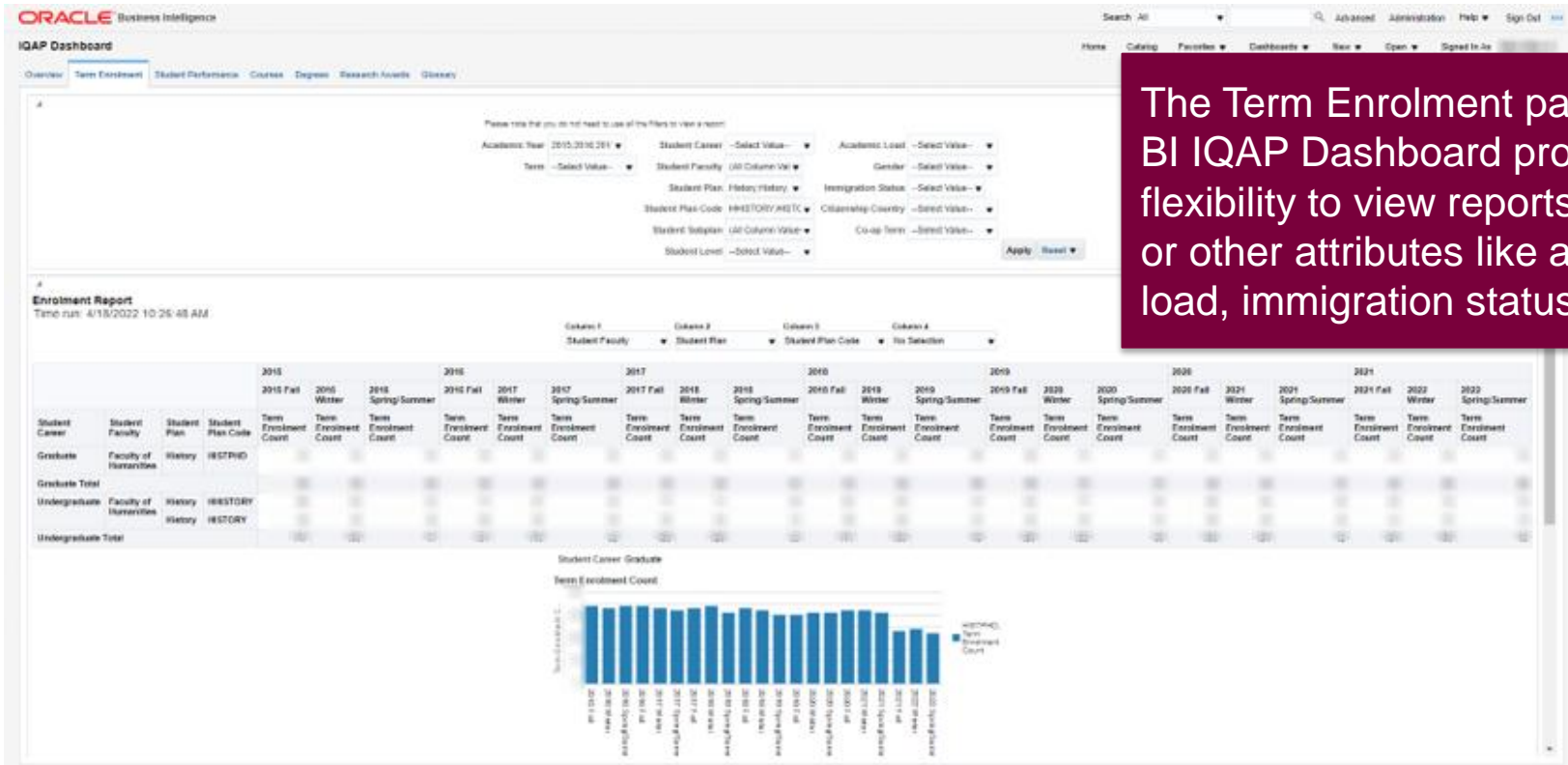

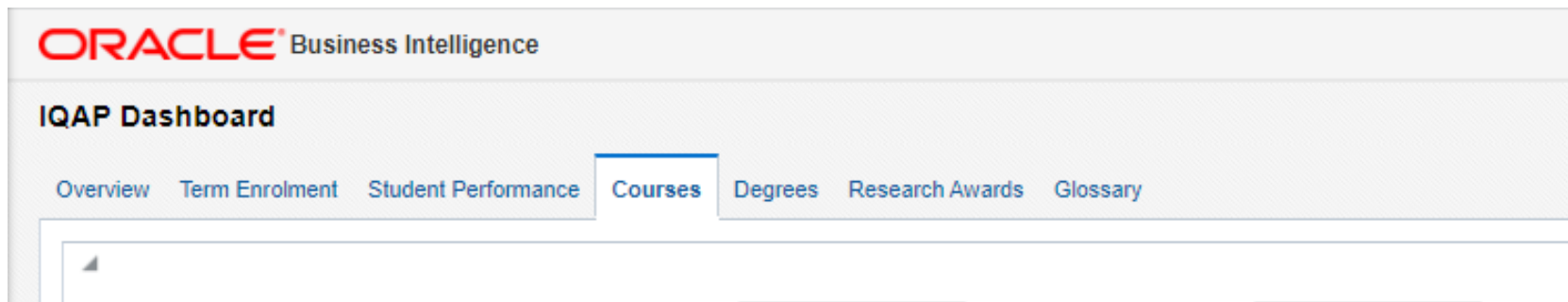
